Happy New Year from everyone at Elmhurst! As we start 2023 the weather feels more like April than January! We had a stretch of sub zero temperatures over Christmas weekend. The evening of Christmas Eve our weather station recorded a temperature of -6 and wind gusts over 40mph. While we did suffer some frozen pipes in the clubhouse, the golf course did just fine. Luckily we had a blanket of snow as the polar vortex delivered record low temperatures. When grass is exposed to real feel temperatures as low as -40 it can cause significant desiccation. We are taking advantage of the warm stretch and working on drainage throughout the property. We currently have projects open on 5 approach, 6 left side rough, and 10 left side rough. We will continue to work on drainage as long as Mother Nature allows! Hopeful temps stay just above average for us, but time will tell!!
